Gurugram, the second largest city in the state of Haryana is a reflection of an ideal modern city and futuristic goals. Officially known as Gurugram, this city has grown from a sleepy town to a fast paced urban centre in a very short span. Witnessing rapid urbanisation, Gurugram has become a leading financial and industrial hub with the third-highest per capita income in India. The city's rise to economic stronghold began with the establishment of Maruti Suzuki India Limited and today it harbours hundreds of Fortune 500 companies.

The city was named after revered teacher Dronacharya of epic Mahabharata. It is believed that Dronacharya was gifted this ancestral village by his disciples, the Pandavas and Kauravas. He gave spiritual instructions to them at this place.

Today the same place is marked with development, modern facilities and a planned infrastructure. The public-private sector partnership model in real estate development has been the major force behind Gurugram's emergence as the corporate capital. Its close proximity to the National Capital

Region has also resulted in Gurugram becoming a corporate hub of BPO companies, IT companies, etc. in an uptrend in the hospitality industry here, with MICE tourism being the major driving force.

Gurugram with its location on NH-8, closer to international airport, offers world-class commercial development, entertainment centres and shopping complexes.

Apart from being a city with throbbing commercial activities, Gurugram is also blessed with quite a few tourist destinations that are worth exploring. These are listed below:

1. DLF CYBER HUB:

The DLF Cyber City is a corporate park in Gurgaon, India, which houses some of the top IT & Fortune 500 companies. It has been termed a "futuristic commercial hub". Cyber City is considered one of the largest hubs of IT activity in Delhi-NCR. It lies near Udyog Vihar, which is a conventional industrial area on the opposite side of NH-8. Cyber Hub, which is primarily an eating area with a large number of leading restaurants besides a

few shops is located next to Cyber City and caters primarily to the people working in DLF Cyber City.

2. AMBIENCE MALL, GURUGRAM

Ambience Mall is a shopping mall in Gurugram, Haryana, India. It contains an area of 1,997,378 square feet. Most floors have a shopping area of 860 meters. Ambience Mall has more than 230 stores and food outlets. Its parking space can accommodate about 4000 vehicles. The mall was opened for public in 2007. It has won the "Best Shopping Center of the Year" and "Most Admired Shopping Centre of the Year" awards.

It is India's largest shopping mall and Asia's second largest mall.

It was Asia's largest mall till 2016.

3. KINGDOM OF DREAMS

Kingdom of Dream is India's first live entertainment, theatre and leisure destination. It is located in Sector 29, Gurgaon, Haryana in NCR Delhi, near the Leisure Valley Park. Spread over 6 acres (24,000 m2) and built at a cost of over Rs. 2 billion, Kingdom of Dreams is run by the Great Indian Nautanki Company (GINC), a joint venture between Apra Group and Wizcraft. The destination consists of two theatres, Nautanki Mahal and the Showshaa Theatre, and a cultural and cuisine area known as Culture Gully. The IIFA Buzz Lounge, a Bollywood-themed resto-bar on the first floor of Culture Gully.

It also showcases Bollywood memorabilia, the IIFA Awards trophy, movie costumes and posters. It was launched on 1 September 2010 by actor, Salman Khan.

4. THE HERITAGE TRANSPORT MUSEUM

The museum is India's major museum dealing with the history of human transportation. It is located at Tauru (Taoru) in the Gurgaon district of the state of Haryana. The collection focuses on the development of transport in India. It is situated on 3.01 acres and has 95,000 square feet of exhibition galleries. When it opened in 2013 it became India's largest private museum. The museum is laid out in twelve collections:

5. SULTANPUR NATIONAL PARK

Formerly known as Sultanpur Bird Park, the National Park it is located at Sultanpur village on Gurugram-Jhajjar highway, 15 km from Gurugram, Haryana and 50 km from Delhi in India. Sultanpur Bird Sanctuary is a very popular national park of India. located in Sultanpur village, Farukhnagar, Gurugram district in Haryana State. Sultanpur village is located 40 km from Dhaula Kuan in Delhi and 15 km from Gurugram city on the Gurugram – Jhajhar highway. This bird sanctuary, ideal for birding and bird lookers, is best visited in winters when a large number of migratory birds come here.

8. SAI KA ANGAN TEMPLE-

By the grace of Shri Shirdi Sai Baba, it was decided by the Trust to build a temple, which would be different from the conventional temples. The temple was visualized as 'Sai Ka Angan', where the devotees of Sai Baba would find peace and solace and would be seen as the 'Shirdi of North India'. The Temple is located at Gurgaon (near Delhi). On 7th October, 2001, Dr. Satpathyji declared that the temple will be modelled after Shirdi's Dwarka Mai, the abode of Shri Sai Nath till He took his Samadhi. for the numerous Sai devotees who have not got a chance to visit Shirdi. The Dwarka Mai temple replica was constructed, with a life size idol of Sai Baba in a sitting posture in front of the Dhuni. Spread over an area of 4000 square yards, there was ample space within the complex, to build more structures connected with Shri Sai Baba's stay at Shirdi.
